## *Why a Men's Accountability Group?* (Exodus 17:9-16, Proverbs 27:17)

- Men can trust their friends.
- Men can pray for one another.
- Men can receive help from one another.
- Men must rally around the banner of the Lord.

## Logistics

- Agree on a time and place to meet.
- Meet once a week. It's critical that each man be able to attend all the meetings on a weekly basis.
- Limit the size of the group to four men.

## Meeting Format Guidelines

- Opening-10 minutes: Socializing and fellowship.
- Main-40 minutes: Bible Study lesson, take turns being the facilitator.
- Final-10 minutes: -Prayer requests and closing prayer by each member.
- Confidentially Pledge: What's said within the group stays within the group.

## Accountability Questions:

- 1. Have you consistently spent time reading the Bible, in Bible Study, in prayer and in worship? Are you growing spiritually?
- 2. Are you actively seeking to reach any unsaved person through prayer and witnessing?
- 3. Is your relationship with your spouse, your children, and your family right before God? Have you been investing your time in their lives?
- 4. Have you been with any person of the opposite sex in such a way that was inappropriate or could have looked to others as if you were using poor judgment?
- 5. Are you harboring hate, jealousy, anger, or unforgiveness towards anyone at this time?
- 6. Have you controlled your tongue, consistently being truthful with others, avoiding gossip, slander, profanity, and unnecessary harshness?
- 7. Is there any activity or substance that currently has (or is beginning to have) an inappropriate, addictive control over your life?
- 8. Have you avoided viewing any sexually explicit material and have you endeavored to maintain a pure thought life?
- 9. Have you been honest with others and completely above reproach in all your financial dealings?
- 10. Have you just been truthful in your response to these questions?
