

Guidelines for Worshiping Together in the Church Building

- We ask that you stay home if you are not feeling well.
- Immune-compromised members and members with co-morbidities (heart, liver, cancer, COPD, asthma, chemo, etc.) will be strongly encouraged to continue to watch online or listen by phone.
- Hand sanitizer is available to be used upon entrance and exit of church.
- Seating is available for those who wish to maintain social distancing and the use of masks. Benches that should not be used are marked, and a 6-foot measuring stick will be available in each pew to indicate the distance we need to maintain from one another.
- Offering baskets will be available in the Sanctuary Hallway before and after the worship to receive our gifts.
- Communion: The Lord's Supper will be served on the 2nd Sunday of the month. The Elders will hand out sealed bread and juice at the door as people enter the building. After communion, we ask that everyone put the empty cup back into the bread bag and dispose of it in the wastebasket at the door as you walk out. Elders will offer to bring communion to those members who are not able to attend in person.
- If you're uncomfortable with this plan, we encourage you to worship online.
